

# Adult Information and Application Form

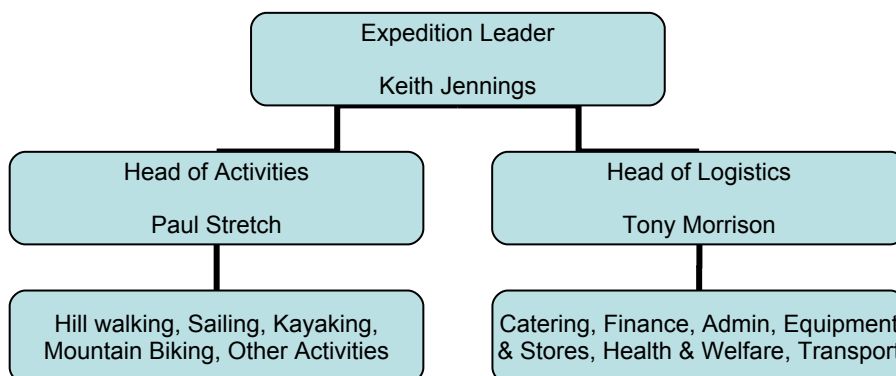

## **Transport**

We have not included any transport for adults to Scotland as we know that many of you would like to make your own arrangements. However, we do have some spaces available on the coach for only £35 return and would encourage you to book one of these. If you choose to use public transport to Scotland, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to provide airport/station transfers.

## **Activity Days**

There will be 11 days of activities whilst in Scotland. If all goes well, every adult should get at least a couple of days off to do as they please. We are planning a full range of evening activities this year, and we will be asking each adult to be involved with one or two evening activities during our stay.

## **Families**

Space at the Station is quite limited. If you would like other family members to be in the area during the expedition, we have details of many types of accommodation available locally.

## **What You'll Pay**

The core cost for our time in Scotland – that will cover accommodation, food, activities, and a polo shirt will be £130 per head.

Optional extras of a Nicholson tartan Buff (£8.50) and neckerchief (£5.00) will be available.

If you wish to use the door-to-door coach transport this will cost just £35 return.

If you join us for the walking or water sports weekend, there will be a nominal charge for food and accommodation.

A deposit of £50 per head is required with each adult application.

## **When Should I Apply?**

As soon as you can! Applications from adults should be received by Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> November. We would like to have our full leader team sorted (and possibly on show) for the participants' meeting on 25<sup>th</sup> November.
